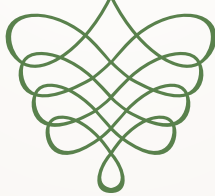



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# ICAR-KVK, BALLARI

In a significant step towards enhancing agricultural productivity and ensuring food security, ICAR-KVK Ballari has initiated the distribution of improved seed varieties to farmers in and around the Ballari district. Under the esteemed guidance of the KisanSamridhhi initiative, KVK Ballari has made available the seeds of Bengalgram variety JG-11 and Safflower PSNB-12, known for their resilience and higher yield potential. These seeds, exclusively available at KVK Ballari, have been meticulously selected to suit the agro-climatic conditions of the region, promising to bring a transformative change to the farming community.

## ► Bengalgram JG-11: A Path to Prosperity

The Bengalgram variety JG-11 is celebrated for its adaptability to the semi-arid climate of Ballari. With a short growth duration and tolerance to pests and diseases, JG-11 ensures a higher yield and better quality of produce. This variety has been distributed to over 1,500 farmers, covering an approximate area of 8,500 acres across the district. Compared to traditional varieties, JG-11 has shown a yield increase of 20-25%, leading to an estimated gross income of around ₹35,000 per acre, as opposed to ₹25,000 from other commonly used varieties. This significant income boost is a direct result of the improved yield and quality, making JG-11 a game-changer



for the farming community in Ballari.

## ► Safflower PBNS-12: Enhancing Crop Diversity

Safflower, traditionally grown for its oil, is a crucial crop for the drylands of Ballari. The PBNS-12 variety of Safflower distributed by KVK Ballari is recognized for its drought tolerance and high oil content. This variety has been adopted by approximately 700 farmers, covering an area of around 2,000 acres in and around Ballari and Anantpur district of Andhra Pradesh. The gross income from PBNS-12 is projected to be around ₹28,000 per acre, which is significantly higher than the



₹20,000 per acre from other varieties grown in the same region. The higher oil content and better drought resistance of PBNS-12 have led to increased profitability, making it a preferred choice among farmers seeking to diversify their cropping systems and maximize returns.

The Kisan Samridhhi initiative by KVK Ballari embodies the vision of creating a prosperous and self-reliant farming community. Through the distribution of these improved seed varieties, KVK Ballari is not just providing seeds but sowing the

# ICAR-KVK, BENGALURU RURAL

**S**HGs, agripreneures and entrepreneurs through technical guidance and creating marketing channel under Kisan Samridhhi Brand for their products. Smt. Padmini Gowda an enthusiastic women agri entrepreneur from Bengaluru Rural District. She was always had zeal and enthusiastic to start agricultural enterprise. But she was unaware of agri related enterprises to start. After getting the technical guidance and support from KVK and Horticulture department.

She started milky mushroom cultivation, areca nut plate making, ground nut and coconut wood pressed oil extraction unit. With the technical support of KVK she started to market her products under the brand name ‘Sri Sai Hanuman Foods and Arecaware’.

Around 30 - 35 kg of milky mushroom is being harvested every day and supplying to big basket and other customers directly @ Rs. 250 per kg and earns 12 lakh per year. She also prepare 2800 number of areca plates per day and generates Rs. 10 lakh per year. She also produces 400 liters of wood pressed coconut and groundnut oil and earns 16 lakh per year. With the guidance of KVK she expanded her business with the Kisan Samridhhi Co-branding.

In coming days with the technical guidance of Krishi Vigyan Kendra Arkavathi FPO, One SHG, Four Entrepreneurs from Bengaluru Rural District will use Kisan Samridhhi Brand to market their produce.



# ICAR-KVK, BIDAR

ICAR - Krishi Vigyan Kendra (KVK) Bidar has been at the forefront of promoting sustainable agricultural practices in the Bidar district of Karnataka. By embracing innovative technologies and promoting high-quality agricultural products under the Kisan Samridhibrand, KVK Bidar is not only enhancing the profitability of local farmers but also contributing to the broader goal of sustainability. The branding of these products plays a critical role in ensuring the reliability and marketability of these goods, thus driving higher profitability for the farmers.

**Empowering Local Enterprises:** Two prominent local enterprises have emerged as key players in this success story: M/S. Bhasan Enterprises and Bhavani Organic Farms. These enterprises, under the guidance and support of KVK Bidar, have successfully produced and marketed a variety of agricultural products that are not only high in quality but also environmentally friendly.

## 1. M/S. Bhasan Enterprises: Led by Sri.

Sanjeevkumar Bhasan, this enterprise has focused on the production and sale of millet-based products and other value-added goods. The production figures and their corresponding market values are impressive:

- **Millet Health Mix Powder (1 kg & 500g):** With 21,000 packets of 1



kg and 36,000 packets of 500g produced, the total revenue generated from these products alone amounts to ₹1,84,77,000.

- **Multi Millet Khichdi, Dosa Rava, and other Millet-based products:** These innovative and healthy products have contributed significantly to the enterprise's revenue, with a combined total value of ₹98,28,100.

- **Cold Pressed Oils and Pickles:** The enterprise has also ventured into the production of cold-pressed oils and various pickles, adding another ₹61,33,500 to their revenue stream.

In total, M/S. Bhasan Enterprises has achieved a remarkable total revenue of ₹2,82,25,600 through the Kisan Samridhibrand. This success is a testament to the importance of quality branding in promoting reliable products and ensuring higher profitability.

**2. Bhavani Organic Farms:** Another success story is that of Bhavani Organic Farms, managed by Sri. Suraj Patil. This farm has specialized in the production of vermicompost and enriched vermicompost, which are essential for sustainable farming practices. The farm's products are in high demand due to their quality and effectiveness in enhancing soil fertility.

- **Vermicompost:** With a production of 150 tonnes, packaged in 40kg bags, Bhavani Organic Farms has generated a revenue of ₹18,75,000.
- **Enriched Vermicompost:** Additionally, 5 tonnes of enriched vermicompost have been produced, bringing in another ₹1,50,000.

The total revenue from Bhavani Organic Farms stands at ₹20,25,000, showcasing the viability and profitability of organic farming practices. ICAR Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Belagavi-1 (Tukkanatti) has trained the different SHG's members (Farm women's) across the KVK Jurisdiction area on processing and value addition to agriculture and horticulture produce to the rural women and SHG's. After the training program women established their own

processing units are "Organic Jaggery Powder Making, Organic Turmeric Powder Making unit, Edible Oil Extraction unit, Millet Health Mix unit, Millet Bakery Products unit and Millet Crisp Roti unit and Turmeric Pickle Making units at different villages of across Belagavi District under the technical guidance of KVK, Belagavi-1. Their main motto behind these processing unit is to provide chemical free

and natural food products to the society. The enterprises are running very successfully and gaining popularity in Belagavi District. Products are getting better acceptance, besides being able to earn a stable income from these enterprises. Soon these products are brought under Kisan Samriddhi Trademark and sold under Kisan Samriddhi Trade.

## ICAR-KVK, BELAGAVI-2

The term “entrepreneurship” represents much more than just starting a business. It defines a creative vision, risk-taking, and a relentless pursuit of opportunity.

The significance of entrepreneurship development is crucial, as it plays a pivotal role in shaping the destiny of nations, empowering individuals, and addressing modern challenges. Entrepreneurship development plays a pivotal role in fostering the growth and success of aspiring business leaders. It includes various educational programs, coaching sessions, and training initiatives aimed at enhancing the knowledge and skills of entrepreneurs.

The primary objective of this development process is to bolster the entrepreneurial ecosystem by empowering individuals to embark on their entrepreneurial journeys. The main benefits of entrepreneur development are Innovation and creativity, economic growth, creation of jobs and improvement in the quality of life.

Self Help Groups (SHGs) have emerged as a crucial instrument for realizing Localization of Sustainable Development Goals (LSDGs) and strengthening of local economy through Vocal for Local. SHGs have now become a platform for many group-based interventions based on the basic premises that mobilization of marginalized and poor (women) people have higher outreach of interventions to improve the rural development outcomes.

Although, the impact of SHGs on development outcomes is much talked about, equal impetus should be given to talk about

what the development organizations and stakeholders can do for the SHG-growth. As the requirement of next-tier of SHGs as small and viable enterprises has emerged, there is a need to go beyond the established value chains and identify areas where further business development of SHGs can take place.

**Mentoring and Handholding by KVK:** After systematically following of SWOT analysis, Krishi Vigyan Kendra initiated mentoring and handholding of individual farmer/farmwomen, self help groups (SHG) and farmers producer organizations (FPO) in its jurisdiction. The process of handholding by KVK was carried out focusing mainly on idea generation, action plan for product preparation, mobilization of resources, providing technology of products and marketing with emphasis on vocal for local. Ever since the KVK initiated the EDP activities, some entrepreneurs have developed in the district due to KVK intervention. Initially these entrepreneurs are mere individuals practicing farming without having knowledge of either processing or value addition concept for their produce.

### ► KVK Products

To promote and ensure the use of quality seeds, bio products, planting materials, KVK is involved in production of high yielding and recently release varieties of paddy, wheat, rabi jowar, green gram, black gram, bengal gram, soybean and groundnut crops and supplying to the farmers. In addition KVK produces bio-pesticides like Metarizium (powder),



Metarizium (liquid), Noumorea rileyi and bio fertilizer like Rhizobium, PSB, Azatobacter, VAM, Azospirillum and quality planting materials as well as millet based value added products and supplying to the farmers to ensure increase in the productivity at low cost of production and gained higher economic returns among the farmers of the region.

### ► KVK Intervention

Krishi Vigyan Kendra identified few individual farmer/ farmwomen based on their zeal of becoming self employed in the vicinity of their residence and generate some income for their day to day expenditure of the family. At this stage, KVK provided idea of product generation using local farm resources. In addition, KVK organized short training courses to provide the technology for production of value added products and extend hands on experience through skill development. Later, the KVK supported these members with needy equipments to start the entrepreneurship.

### ► Our successful entrepreneurs

**a.Smt. Iravva Mathapati:** KVK trained her family for preparation of pickles and millet biscuits and provided oven and trays to start millet biscuit entrepreneur along with facilitating for branding of biscuits like Millet



bite (foxtail millet), Millet Delight (little millet) and Millet Crunch (finger millet) and also obtained FSSAI license for sale of the products. The pickles are sold in the brand name of 'Shakti'. She provided employment for six women throughout the year. The annual production of pickles is around 100 tons with a turnover of Rs. 53.00 lakhs and millet biscuits worth of Rs. 5.00 lakhs. She was awarded with Krishi Pandit, Shresta Krishi Mahile and DD Mahila Kisan for her entrepreneurship activity.

**b.Smt. Manjula Hiremath:** KVK provided hands on training for preparation of millet roti's and facilitated for marketing in Mela's, workshops, marriages and other social events. After the training she owned a big roti making machine with a capacity of 1000 rotis/ day. KVK backstopped her entrepreneurship at every step during the process. She employees 3 workers daily for preparation of products. Annually she produces 60,000 millet rotis with



a turnover of Rs. 3.00 lakhs/ year.

**c. Smt. Laxmi Lagamma Ramannavar:**

She resides in Nesargi village near KVK campus. She attended on campus training on income generating activities at KVK and motivated by Scientist. She purchased the vermicelli machine and started the production on commercial scale. Annually she produces 12 tons of vermicelli with a turnover of Rs. 8.00 lakhs/ year along with providing employment for two women.



**d. Smt. Bharati Badiger:** Before 2013, she was working in a private hospital for which she have to travel 100km/ day. During 2013, she attended a training at KVK and acquired knowledge on processing and value addition of millets and wheat for preparation of standardized vermicelli items along with sweet potato products with technical backstopping by KVK. KVK facilitated the entrepreneur for getting FSSAI licence and branding. She started millet vermicelli preparation like finger millet, foxtail millet, proso millet, bardnyard millet, sorghum and papads. She is also into the business of roti and millet flour. She is participating in various



workshops, Krishi Melas, exhibitions and exhibits the products and sell the products. She is providing employment continuously for two women workers throughout the year. She has been honored with ATMA award at district level and acting as resource person in the training programme for empowerment of women. The production is 2.5 tons with a turnover of Rs. 2.0 lakhs/ year.

► **SHGs:**

**Shree Lakshmi Stree Shakti Swa Sahaya Sangha, Sutagatti,**

KVK organized five days vocational training programme on tying and dyeing techniques using natural dyes in collaboration with AICRP on Home Science (Clothing and Textiles), UAS, Dharwad under DBT project entitled “Empowerment of Rural Women



through Natural Tying technology”. KVK gave hands on experience to the members of Sangha on Natural Dying and Stitching which includes dying of clothes using marigold, teak and areca nut slurry, quality stitching of dyed clothes hemming techniques on commercial basis, different methods of tying the clothes, preparation of duppattas, kurtas and baby frock and eco-friendly baby kit. Further, they were imparted with skills on cutting, stitching and finishing of the fabric, packing, branding of the kit and pricing of the product. All the members of the SHG are preparing the eco-friendly baby kit at common point based on the demand and sell at the major hospitals in Belagavi city. Annually, they are preparing 300 baby kits with a turnover of Rs. 98.00 thousands / year.

► **Farmers producer Organizers (FPOs):**

1. Belagavi Samagra Krushi Raita Utpadakara Sahakara Sangha Niyamita, Belagavi
2. This FPO was registered under co-operative society’s act 1967. KVK provided production technology, packing and marketing aspects of okra and bitter melon. The products are marketed directly in Goa, Maharashtra and Gujarat states. The annual production is 500 tons with a turnover of Rs. 1.24 crores.



► **2. Mahantha FPO, Hosur Savadatti**

This FPO after taking the guidance from KVK Scientists started the extraction of edible oil like soybean, groundnut, safflower and coconut oil. The annual production of oil is 455 ltrs with a gain of Rs. 1.52 lakhs/ year by marketing the produce local vendors.

also featured prominently, with the production of Bio-fertilizers, Bio-fungicides, Bio-agents, and Organic inputs totaling 12,424 kg. The highest value was derived from Bio-fungicides, which generated Rs. 294,824. The overall value from bio-products reached

Rs. 1,159,016. Livestock and fisheries produced 3,791 units, with Chicks (Krishibro BV-380, Gramasree, Kadakkanath) being the primary contributor, generating Rs. 708,146. The total value from livestock and fisheries stood at Rs. 852,021.

Ragi, Millets, Field bean, cowpea, Niger, Chia Planting material: Curryleaf, Drumstick, Mango, Arecanut, Chayya, Chakramuni, Dragon, medicinal Plants and Vermicompost and sells farm Fresh Mango under Kissan Samruddi. KVK Ramanagara also involved in promoting the entrepreneur products of Mr. Rajashekar, Kartavya Enterprises, Kanakapura which sells products like Rice, Ragi, Horsegram papads, Mrs. Prasheela, Swadishta Enterprises Products, Kanakapura sells white Ragi malt, mixture, papad, Rice and Horsegram papads under this brand and also promoting Smt. Suvrna from Gavinagmangala of Magadi to sell honey under Kissan Samruddhi.

► Availability of agriculture inputs at KVK, Shivamogga under Kissan Samriddhi

1) **Trichoderma:** Trichoderma is one of the important biopesticide used to control different soil borne diseases. Horticulture crops are predominantly grown in Shivamogga district, with these facts KVK, Shivamogga under revolving fund activity started the production of liquid Trichoderma under logo of Kissan Samriddhi for the benefit of the farming community. So far, 45 liters of liquid Trichoderma was sold to 20 farmers.

2) **Value added products:** Promoting diversified value added products developed under the brand name of KISSAN SAMRIDDHI such Finger millet cookies, Fig candy, Sorghum plum cake, Jamun seed cookies, value added finger millet flour, Ground cake chips, ginger powder, BAKAHU (Dehydrated Banana flour) cookies, little millet sweet and spicy cookies etc. A total of 190 kg products have been sold.

3) **Seedlings:** KVK, Shivamogga is producing a quality planting materials of different fruits seedlings and farm products under Kissan Samriddhi brand ICAR- Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Shivamogga. In 100 days programme a total 651 seedlings, poultry birds 15 and eggs of desi birds 150 No. were sold.

## ► Ragi malt

Ragi malt is prepared from ragi, wheat, green gram, cardmamon, badam and cashew. Finger millet or ragi is one of the important minor cereals of India and Africa. The millet is a good source of dietary carbohydrates, protein, calcium and micronutrients and hence, its malt is also a good source of protein, carbohydrates and many other nutrients besides hydrolytic enzymes. Malted ragi flour can be used in preparation of weaning food, infant food, geriatric food, medical foods and also as milk based as well as alcoholic beverage formulations. It can be used as amylase rich food (ARF) to reduce the 'dietary bulk' of energy food and such other supplementary foods.

Malting is one of the traditional processes adopted for preparation of food and beverages. Sprouting improves protein and carbohydrate digestibility and extractability of P, Ca, Fe and Zn. Ragi malt can be used as amylase rich food to reduce the bulk of weaning food. Ragi is a very potential grain for malting and preparation of several health foods, weaning food in

particular. The malted millet is a rich source of digestive enzymes, calcium and iron and its protein is a good source of sulphur amino acid.

Ragi malt is prepared from ragi, wheat, green gram, cardmamon, badam and cashew. Ragi or Finger Millet, wheat, green gram are cleaned, washed thoroughly and left to soak for 12 hours. It is then sprouted over the next 24 hours in clean cotton cloths, further sun-dried and milled in pulverizer by adding cardmamon, badam and cashew.

## ► 2. Millets Health Mix

Wash all millets well and soak in water overnight. Then rinse well, drain the water, tie it in a muslin cloth and kept for sprouting to occur. After it has sprouted, rinse gently, spread on a cloth for drying. Dry under the sun or shade. After it has dried well, dry roast



it till you get a nice aroma. Repeat the same process for green gram, horse gram and bengal gram. Dry roast dry ginger, badam and cashew nut separately. Now combine all ingredients and grind in flour mill.

### ▶ 3. Karonda pickle

Karonda pickle is made out of karonda which is a type of berry which is green and sour when unripe and turns red and sweet as it ripens.

Karonda, the wonder fruit has been used for its medicinal properties. The fruit is rich in Vitamin C and has antiscorbutic (effective in prevention or relief of scurvy) properties. It is rich in Iron and is used for treatment of anaemia. It also has anti-microbial and antifungal properties. Traditionally karonda juice was used to clean old wounds which have become infected. It has been used for treatment of anorexia and also has analgesic and anti-inflammatory properties. Recent research suggests that Karonda helps in lowering cholesterol levels too. Karonda is widely used in preparation of jams, jellies, pickles, chutney, squash and syrups.

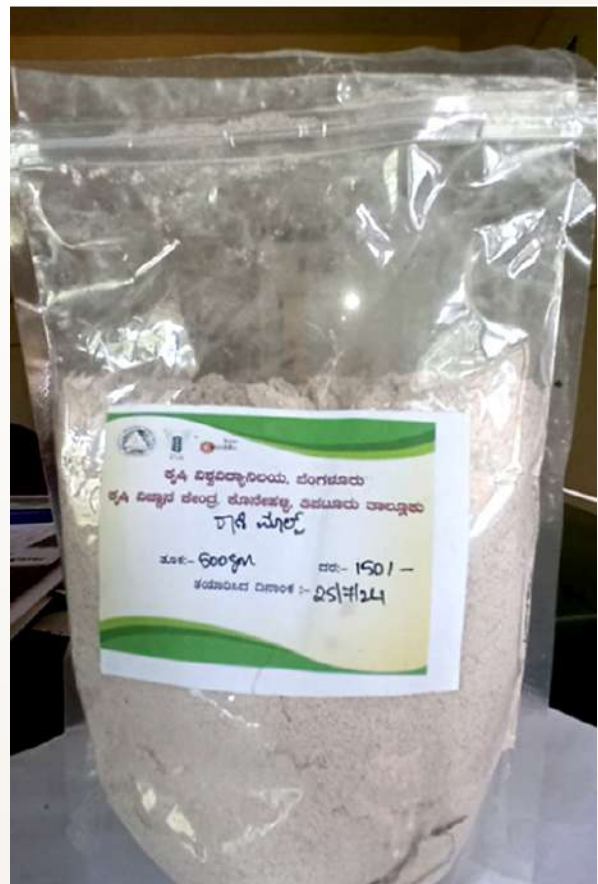
### ▶ 4. Amla candy

Amla is an indigenous fruit to the Indian subcontinent. It is a fruit that is now underutilized but has huge potential in the global market. It has got great potential in processed forms, such as candy. The medicinal, nutritional, and organoleptic quality of amla candy can be improved by the addition of different syrups in the amla candy like rose syrup, tulsi syrup, and ginger syrup. Delicious and healthy amla candy made using gooseberry cooked in sugar and dried in sun.

Amla candies are rich in vitamin c – a necessary nutrient for repairing body tissues, and bones and boosting the immune system. It is rich in antioxidants and anti-inflammatory properties that help to fight harmful infection and improves the body's metabolism.

### ▶ 5. Direct market linkage between Jackfruit growers to consumer under kisan samruddhi

ICAR – Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Tumkur – I supported direct market facility of jack fruit from farmer to consumer by at Benagaluru-shivamogga national high way on 03-08-2024 and 13-08-2024. During this, 03 farmers were participated and sold their farm jack fruit and value- added product like chips, Halva, papad, Nector etc., and got good profit within a span of time.

The products being produced and sold from KVK Hirehalli include AMC Liquid and Powder, Foliar Nutrient formulations for Banana, Vegetables, Citrus, Mango Special, Fruitfly traps and lures, Neem & Pongamia Soap, and Arka Borer Controller, along with support provided to a few agri-entrepreneurs by KVK.

## I. KVKs

### ARKA BANANA SPECIAL ಅರ್ಕಾ ಬಾಳೆ ಸ್ಪೆಷಲ್

Foliar Spray Formulation A product of ICAR-IIHR, Bengaluru



Balanced nutrition is very important for high yield, quality and resistance to diseases, however very few farmers use micronutrient fertilizers. Due to low organic matter in Indian soil, excessive use of DAP and introduction of high yielding cultivars and fast growing tissue culture plants, deficiency of micronutrients has become a major problem. But soil degradation, poor root health and excessive use of phosphorous has made correction of nutrient disorders through soil very difficult. The efficiency of utilisation of soil applied micronutrient is only 3 to 5%. Hence, "Banana Special" foliar spray as a part of Integrated Nutrient Management has become important in enhancing the yield and quality of Banana.

#### How to use :

- 1) Add 75 g of Banana Special + one shampoo sachet + Juice of 2 lemon fruits in 15 litres of water and mix thoroughly before spraying.
- 2) Start spraying on plants from 5th month onwards and once in 30 days and continue upto 10th month stage.
- 3) For better results it should be applied during dull sunshine hours (morning or evening) and bright sun light should be avoided.

- 2) ಬೆಳೆ ನಾಟಿ ಮಾಡಿದ 5 ತಿಂಗಳಿಗಾಗ ನಂತರ, ಪ್ರತಿ ತಿಂಗಳು ನಿರಂತರವಾಗಿ ಮಾರುವುದು. 10 ತಿಂಗಳಿಗಾಗ ವರೆಗೆ ನಿರಂತರವಾಗಿ ಮಾರಬೇಕು.

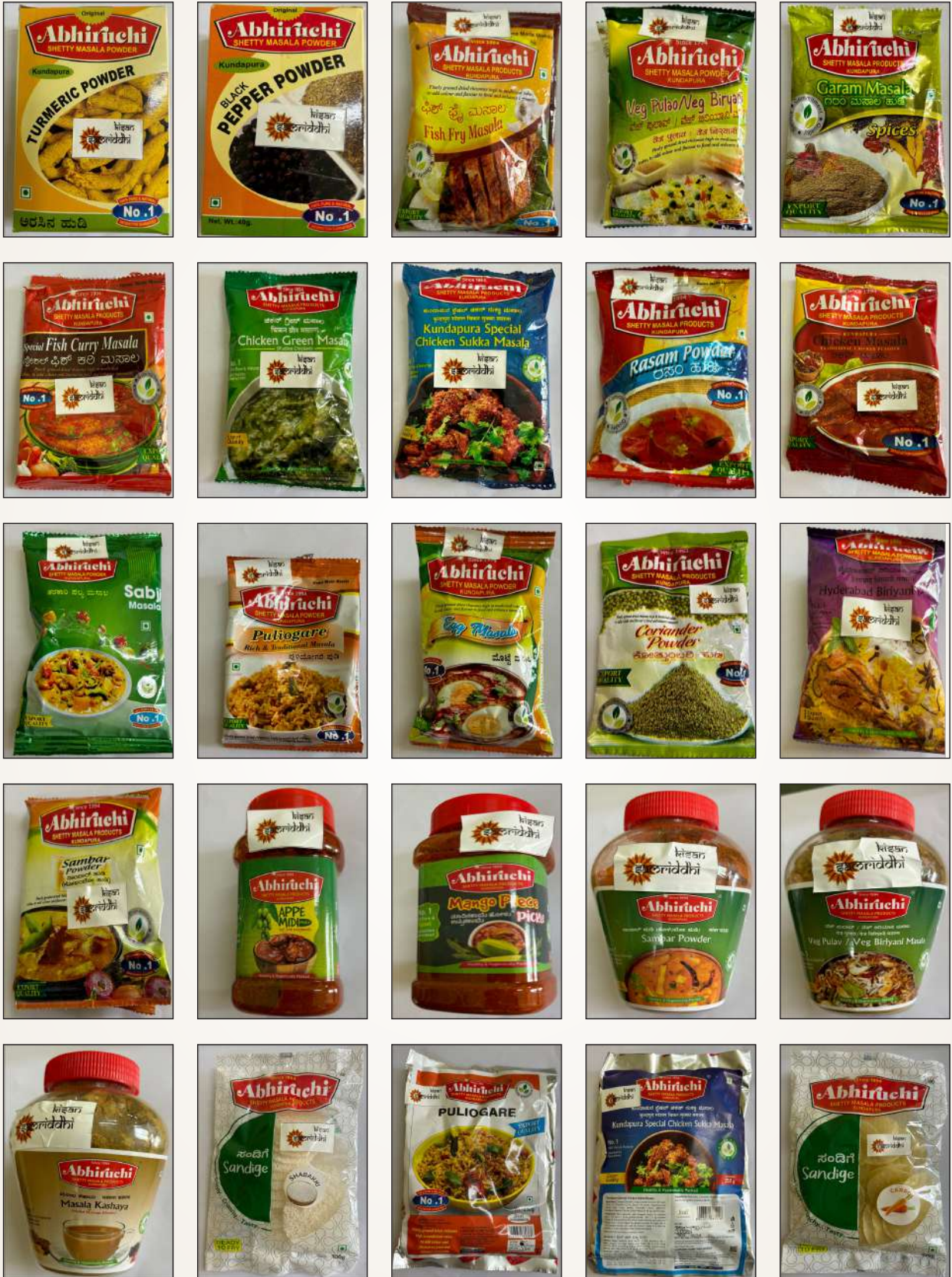

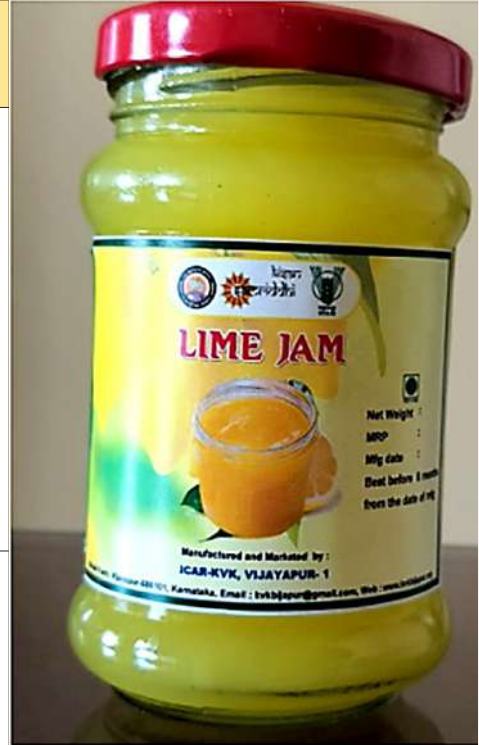

## ► Common Facilitation Centre and Processing unit

One of the significant components of KVK is the processing lab, which focuses on processing, value addition and post-harvest management of agricultural produce, since 2014. A common facilitation centre (CFC) is functioning under this KVK since 2017. This performs a variety of functions which can be broadly categorized into product development and processing, training and capacity building, entrepreneurship support and promotion, research and development etc.

Many people are benefited from these facilities in various ways either by utilizing the machineries for processing and value addition of their agricultural produce or by attending training classes, workshops and demonstrations on various aspects of food processing and preservation conducted by KVK. By focusing on training and capacity building programmes; KVK significantly contributes to increasing farmers' income and employment; and also has empowered women and rural youth by enabling them to actively participate in food processing sector.

This unit produces a range of value-added products such as squash, syrup, chips, powder, pickles, etc., from many crops like ginger, green mango, aonla, birds eye chilli, banana, jackfruit, garlic, coconut, beetroot, carrot, coffee, passionfruit etc. The list of products produced from this unit are as follows: Ginger squash, Grape squash, Amla ginger squash, Amla chilly squash, Amla syrup, Green

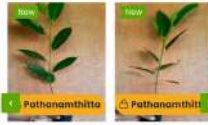
